Al tools should be used to support learning and enhance education, not replace teachers, and users should verify Al outputs to ensure accuracy and alignment with educational goals.



2. Data Privacy

Protect student and staff information by not sharing sensitive data with AI tools, using generalized data instead, and utilizing District-approved platforms while adhering to their privacy policies.



3. Legal Compliance

Al use must comply with laws and regulations such as FERPA, COPPA, CIPA, HIPAA, and Nevada Revised Statutes, as well as District policies, to ensure the privacy and security of student data.



4. Copyrighted Material
