



Clark County School District 2021–2022 Pandemic EBT Distribution

What is P-EBT?

The Pandemic EBT Program (P-EBT) is a one-time federal COVID-19 related program that allows school children who are enrolled and eligible for free or reduced-priced meals through the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Program (NSLP) to receive a food benefit on an electronic benefit card for the days they did not receive a meal service at their school because of a COVID-19 related absence or COVID-19 related school closure.

Benefit Issuance

Free or reduced-price meal eligible children will receive a benefit of \$7.10 for each day the child had a qualifying absence due to COVID-19.

- The first set of P-EBT benefits for the school months of August 2021–November 2021, will go out September 14–23, 2022.
- The second set of P-EBT benefits for the school months of December 2021–February 2022 and Summer P-EBT, will go out October 14–23, 2022.
- The third set of P-EBT benefits for the months of March 2022–June 2022, will go out November 14–23, 2022.
- Summer P-EBT: All free or reduced-price meal eligible children from 2021–2022 SY will receive a standard one-time benefit of \$391.00. This benefit will be issued in the month of October 2022.
